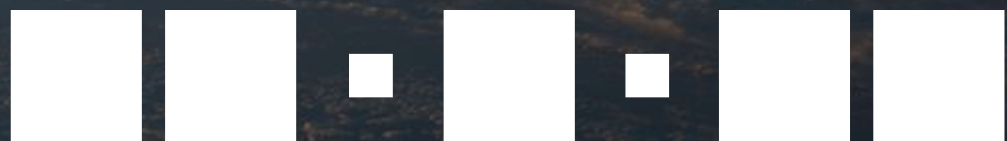

IGS Network Summary for 2021

- Currently 509 IGS stations: 444 have supplied data in the last 10 days
 - Multi-GNSS stations increased from 326->353
 - Real-time stations increased from 270->292
- 7 New IGS stations added in collaboration with IC Chair and GB Network Representatives
- 4 IGS stations decommissioned
- 25 changes to the rcvr_ant.tab file in collaboration with AWG Chair
- Provided user support for the Site Log Manager
 - 662 site log updates (~60 per month)
 - 9 antenna changes, 2 of them at IGS14 Core stations

IGS Network Summary 2021

- rt.igs.org now fully operated by UCAR at beginning of 2021
- Answer ~130 user questions/issues
- Ongoing work includes:
 - monitor station log/RINEX metadata
 - Coordinate new IGS station proposals
 - Coordinate new entries into the `rcvr_ant.tab` and `antenna.gra` files
- Encourage station operators to use generic agency contacts instead of person specific contact information for EU GDPR compliance (examples CKIS, VNDP)
- Encourage station operators to provide multi-GNSS data with RINEX3
